What data do we collect?

3D Aim Trainer might collect the following data:

- Contact information: email address
- Your username
- An encrypted string of your password
- Profile information submitted on your 3D Aim Trainer's account page
- Browser behavior
- Website visits
- 3D Aim Trainer related data you generate by using our website, for example which levels you play, your scores/accuracy/... and so on
- Demographic location
- IP address
- Hardware and software related data (browser, OS, screen resolution, user agent, ...)
- Cookie preferences

- Communication preferences
- Eye tracking data for analysis of aim metrics (only when you have a Tobii Eye tracker and opted-in to this service)
- 3D Aim Trainer related settings, for example your game sync settings, the character/weapon/attachment you play with, ...

Please note that this list is non-exhaustive, and might change over time. Contact us if you would require more detailed information about data being collected.

Also note that the list above is about the data 3D Aim Trainer collects. Other service providers we work with, for example Google Analytics, may collect other data types. Please refer to their privacy policy if you would require more information around this, or reach out to us.

How do we collect your data?

- Directly provided by you: data you submit when registering, when completing a survey, when providing feedback on our message boards and social media channels, via email, ...
- Automatically collected, for example browser behavior or IP address.

How will we use your data?

3D Aim Trainer collects your data so that we can, among other things:

- Track and manage your account
- Allow our website to function properly
- Give you insights on your training progress
- Improve our products and services
- Do relevant marketing

If you have agreed to receive marketing 3D Aim Trainer would like to send you information about services of ours that we think you might like.

You may always opt out at a later date. You have the right at any time to stop 3D Aim Trainer from contacting you for marketing purposes.

How long do we store your data?

3D Aim Trainer stores the data of your account as long as you are an active user.

If you haven't used your account within 7 years your data will be deleted from our servers.

With how do we share your data?

Data you generate on our platform is not being sold to any third-party company.

We might share your data with external service providers in order to help us with various things. We share only the information necessary for executing those services.

The type of work that our external service typically provide for us are:

- Digital services such as hosting, maintenance and support of our websites and applications.
- Services regarding advertising and marketing campaigns.

How do we store your data?

Depending on the data point, storage may vary. Persistent data, like your login credentials or training progress, is stored in a MySQL Database. This database is hosted by a third-party hosting provider called Namecheap. Please note that this database is hosted on a Shared Server, and maintained by Namecheap. This server is located in the UK.

Other storage possibilities include storage systems where data is stored on your computer, for example cookies, local storage, and other.

3D Aim Trainer is committed to ensuring that your information is secure. Only 3D Aim Trainer authorized staff members can access your personal data if this is necessary to perform their job. In order to prevent unauthorized access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

What are your data protection rights?

3D Aim Trainer would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

- The right to access - You have the right to request 3D Aim Trainer for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.
- The right to rectification - You have the right to request that 3D Aim Trainer correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request 3D Aim Trainer to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- The right to erasure — You have the right to request that 3D Aim Trainer erase your personal account data, this request will be met within 30 calendar days.
- The right to restrict processing - You have the right to request a restriction on processing your personal data. This means that we have the right to store your data but not use it.
- This right exists in certain cases. If you believe that this is the case, you can contact us at the email address below
- The right to object to processing - You have the right to object to 3D Aim Trainer's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions. The right to data portability - You have the right to request that 3D Aim Trainer transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions
